Weather

It rained in Salinas on Monday but the rest of the week will be mild weather with cold mornings. The desert will be in the high 60's to low 80's.

Quality

Quality is better in the desert, but the weights are very light.

Forecast

We are moving the plant on Thursday to Yuma, so we need to have all orders in our system to know what to produce at our plant.

GREEN LEAF



Iceberg: Lettuce supplies are on budget, but being in Yuma only, it is putting us behind in the cold box. We are transferring daily to cover mixers in Salinas and cannot get ahead for service levels. The good news is the Mix Dock will be open next Monday, 11/18 and we will not need to shuttle any more. The industry overall seems to be short on supplies due to multiple issues. The forecast is for steady to possibly higher prices by the end of the week. Anticipate triggers on both cartons and value-added items.

Green Leaf: Production in the Salinas Valley continues to be light. Supplies continue to decrease as transition to Yuma region is just weeks away. Overall quality is fair at best. Current market is trending stronger with good demand.

Celery: Supplies remain good and we are well positioned for holiday business. Quality is fair to good with some occasional heat related issues. Pre-booking for holiday business is strongly recommended.





ROMAINE HEARTS



We're expecting better supplies for the next 3 weeks as temperatures start to cool down in Northern Mexico.

Production on Romaine and Romaine Hearts is starting in Yuma and quality is fair. Defects are twisting and ribby leaves, mostly due to the recent hot weather. The market is showing strength, and demand is good. Supplies will continue to be a challenge through Thanksgiving.



CAULIFLOWER





Brussels Sprouts: Total available volume again remains strong for this week and the market tone should show signs of improvement in advance of the holiday. Product quality is showing signs of improvement but some mildew stain and rough/elongated seed stem is evident.

Supplies are limited this week and will be for the balance of the season. Demand remains strong and quality is good.

We are still seeing some very light insect pressure in the heads. Overall, quality has continued to improve as we get towards the end of the season which will be November 22. We will start in the desert on Monday, November 25.

Production in Salinas Valley is light and overall quality is fair at best. The Salinas season is winding down and Yuma region just a few weeks out. Demand is good and markets are strong.



Northern supplies will begin to taper off for the coming week but no significant shortages in volume are anticipated. Demand is expected to remain strong in the wake of advancing lettuce and romaine markets. Quality is good but some russet spotting is noted.

Kale supplies are expected to be at budget this week.




