


Iceberg: We have finished in Imperial Valley and will continue in Yuma through the end of the season. The last week of Yuma is April 14th, with Salinas scheduled to start around April 7th. The market stair stepped up last week due to

an increase in demand and slightly lower supplies. This week the forecast is for steady to slightly higher prices depending on industry supplies.

Green Leaf: Production in Imperial Valley is steady. Overall quality is good, with the current market trending higher with good demand.

Celery: Supplies and quality are good this week. Market continues to be steady.

We have very good supplies for the next two weeks.


Romaine and Romaine Hearts are in full harvest in Yuma. We are still experiencing light blister in the plants from previous cold weather. We are hitting springtime with warmer weather now and insect pressure is very active. The market is trending higher with increased demand.



Cauliflower supplies are expected to be at budgeted numbers this week. Overall quality continues to be good, however we are seeing some occasional off-color heads.

Brussels Sprouts: Both domestic and Mexican supplies remain strong and there is no expected change in the total volume outlook for the industry. Both bulk and VA categories are still great options for promotion. Overall quality is very good; some occasional insect injury is present in the domestic crop; Mexico crop is showing good condition but some elongated seed core/stem.

NAPA CABBAGE



Weather has pushed the crop further but we will not be back to regular supply until we finish the Winter pull and get back up to Salinas.









BUTTER LETTUCE



Production in Yuma is steady. Good quality and size profile. Demand is good and the market is trending higher.



LITTLE GEM LETTUCE



There will likely be a drop in production volume in the next 2 weeks that may be impactful as soon as this week. Some quality issues continue to be present including rib discoloration from thrip damage. Off quality will lower yields and reduce total volume. Pre-booking is strongly recommended. Production in Salinas will begin the week of 3/24.



Production in Imperial Valley is steady. Demand continues to be good. Consult with your Church Brothers Farms sales representative to gain more information on this versatile product.



Similar to the gem category, quality is declining as we approach the conclusion of the desert season. Production capacity is expected to be down for the week. Salinas acreage will commence the week of 3/24.
